

Level 2 Extended Certificate in Business – Registrations open from September 2017

Overview

This is a two year practical work-related course where you will learn by completing projects, exams and assignments that are based on realistic workplace situations, activities and demands. This course will introduce you to your chosen career and provide a good basis to progress onto a more advanced qualification. During this course you will study twelve units in total. Two core units and one mandatory unit will provide a general foundation and nine specialist units will introduce you to particular topics in more depth.

Core Units:

- Enterprise in the business world
- Finance for business

Mandatory Unit:

- Principles of marketing

Specialist Units to include:

- Promoting a brand
- Principles of customer service
- Sales and personal selling
- Introducing retail business
- Providing business support
- Recruitment, selection and employment

Outcome

On successful completion of this course you will gain a BTEC Level 2 Extended Certificate in Business qualification. This qualification is equivalent to three GCSEs grades A* - C.

Assessment

Two units on the Level 2 Extended Certificate in Business are assessed through external examination. The other ten units are assessed through project and assignment work. Each unit is graded Pass, Merit or Distinction and then an overall grade of Pass, Merit, Distinction or Distinction* is awarded on completion.

This is a two year course in Digital Applications which has been designed to engage and enthuse young people with an interest in creative computing, for example digital graphics and animations, interactive multimedia products and computer games. On successful completion of this course, you will gain a BTEC Level 2 Diploma in Digital Applications qualification. This qualification is equivalent to four GCSEs grades A* - C.

The units are assessed through project and assignment work. Each unit is graded Pass, Merit or Distinction and then an overall grade of Pass, Merit, Distinction or Distinction* is awarded on completion.
